



Tiup agar separuh angin menghala keluar dari lubang embouchure dan separuh darinya masuk kedalam lubang (macam meniup mulut botol). Buka semua lubang tone holes dan tiup perlahan-lahan dan panjang sehingga mengeluarkan bunyi. Apabila bunyi telah stabil, cuba tutup lubang tone holes mulai dari lubang nombor 6 perlahan-lahan hingga lubang 1.



Tip:

Sewaktu menutup lubang 2 dan lubang 1, anda perlu meniup dengan perlahan berbanding sewaktu meniup dengan lubang 6, 5, 4 dan 3 untuk mengelakkan bunyi tone yang terhasil adalah di octave yang lebih tinggi.



Jumlah aliran angin perlulah dihalakan ke kawasan lubang embouchure sahaja iaitu di kawasan bertanda 'A' di sebelah. Sekiranya aliran angin tersasar ke kawasan 'B', bunyi tone yang dihasilkan tidak 'bersih' kerana bercampur dengan bunyi 'hiss'. Seboleh mungkin sasaran aliran angin ke kawasan 'A' sahaja untuk menghasilkan bunyi yang lunak dan 'dalam'.
